



RoSPA (Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents) is a registered charity dedicated to improving road safety in the UK.

RoSPA Cyprus works with RoSPA in the UK and is committed to the following:

1 - We will provide free help, advice and information to encourage any member of the community of Cyprus to assess the element of risk associated with any road journey for pleasure and business. We will help motorists and riders understand the causes and consequences of road traffic accidents and how best to minimise any involvement in them.

2 - We recognise that advanced drivers and riders are better prepared for the road. Anyone who holds a full driving licence for the class of vehicle they drive or ride may join our Group to acquire advanced driving or riding skills. We advertise our presence throughout Cyprus through promotion by the media, internet forums, local community publications and networking.

3 - We will provide free on road training to anyone interested in becoming an advanced driver or rider. All the training is based on "Roadcraft" the British Police Drivers handbook, under expert guidance from skilled Tutors. They will accompany you in your own vehicle or if you are a rider they will follow you on their own bike. There is no time limit to the amount of training that is provided. And remember all training is free!

4 - The skill of the driver/rider is assessed when they undertake their advanced driving or riding test. All training is designed to ensure that the driver or rider wanting to take their RoSPA advanced driving or riding test is fully prepared and confident to take it. Passes are graded as gold, silver and bronze awards. Our aim is to achieve more than 100 test passes during 2010. There is a fee for the test, which also includes your first year's membership to RoSPA. Currently, it is €66 for a car test and €74 for a bike test. Although if you take into account exchange rates it may be more preferable to pay £48 for a car test or £54 for a bike test.

5 - RoSPA Cyprus will also support RoSPA UK and its nationwide network of over 50 local RoSPA Advanced Drivers and Riders groups (www.roadar.org).

6 - RoSPA Cyprus will also work closely with a wide range of partners in Cyprus who are also committed to promoting increased levels of road safety.
